Welcome to Lower Dauphin High School! I hope that you are having a relaxing and enjoyable summer and that you are excited for the year to come. The purpose of my letter is to inform you of a few items that are very important for the start of the school year.

You will be able to access your preliminary and tentative schedule for the coming school year on Power School on/around August 7<sup>th</sup>. Please be sure to review your schedule carefully. Check that you are carrying the minimum of 7 credits for this year (maximum of one study hall per day) and that the correct classes are listed. You are permitted to make schedule changes until August 18th. Please note that summer schedule changes do NOT include teacher and/or lunch changes.

## Once school begins, the following policy applies:

- Students will remain in classes for the first two weeks of school. No schedule changes will be made.
- In weeks 3 and 4 of school, schedule changes are permitted for academic misplacements (with teacher and parent approval) AND elective changes can be made (from one elective to another – dependent on class space and also with parental approval) – deadline for these types of changes is September 22.
- From week 4 of school through week 7, the ONLY types of changes will be for academic misplacements (with teacher and parent approval) – deadline for a level change is October 25.
- After week 7, no schedule changes will be made unless they are approved by a principal.
- For second semester classes, students will only be able to make a change up until the second week of the course (week 2 of the 3rd marking period)

You may call me at 717-566-5335 or email me at tdreon@ldsd.org to request schedule changes through August 18th. If you do call me, please leave a detailed message on my voice mail with the desired change(s). If you would like to speak with me directly regarding the schedule or other concerns, I will be in the office on the following dates for the remainder of the summer: August 8, 10, 14 and 17.

We hope you can attend New Student Orientation on Wednesday, August 16 6:00-7:30pm. It is an open format so you can come at any point during that time period and have the opportunity to walk through the building with a copy of your schedule in hand. This will help you feel more comfortable finding your way through the hallways during the first week of school. Our Open House will be before the school year starts as well on Thursday, August 24th 6:00-7:30pm. At this event, students and parents will be able to meet teachers, obtain syllabi and see classrooms.
