**PLACE**: Roundtop Mountain Resort - Lewisberry, Pennsylvania

**DATES AND DEPARTURE TIMES**: Trips are scheduled for **Thursday** evenings.

**IF A TRIP IS POSTPONED, we will make it up on February 15th.** Based on weather, trips may be rescheduled on a night other than Thursday night in order to complete our full commitment of trips.

<u>RETURN TIME</u>: We will return to the school by 9:45 pm. All students are to be picked up behind the high school, near the band room, near exits 13 and 14. The building is locked and NO ONE will be able to enter the building when we return. Parents, please be prompt. An advisor will wait at the school until the last student leaves.

**PAYMENT**: Deadline for payment is **Friday**, **December 8**, **2023**. We will take members on a first-come, first-serve basis.

## **RULES & GUIDELINES**

**SCHOOL DELAY**: If there is a delay in the opening of school on the day of a trip, Ski Club will try to go skiing/snowboarding that evening if conditions permit as determined by the administration or the advisors.

**SCHOOL BUSES**: State law does not permit the transport of any objects which cannot safely be held on the student's lap. This means students will not be permitted to bring their skis, poles, or boards on their school bus in the mornings. Parents will need to transport equipment to the middle school on the mornings of Ski Club trips.

**ARRIVAL AT SCHOOL ON THE DAY OF THE SKI TRIP**: You will need to store your extra clothing and equipment until the end of the day. The **TEAM LOCKER ROOM** is available for storage, or you may make arrangements with one of your teachers. Please see a Physical Education teacher if the doors to the locker room are locked.

**ABSENCE FROM TRIPS**: Students who miss trips will need to make them up on their own and find their own transportation to Roundtop. We only provide transportation for 5 trips.

TRANSPORTATION: All participants <u>must</u> ride the buses to and from Roundtop on the nights of our scheduled trips. Lower Dauphin School District will not be responsible for students who chose to drive on their own. Parents may bring their child home from Roundtop, but must give written notice or personally speak with a Ski Club advisor. Buses will line up outside the band room/woodshop area at the HS. They will arrive at 2:30, loading until 2:45. Leaving PROMPTLY at 2:45.

<u>SKI EQUIPMENT</u>: All middle and high school students will place their skis, poles, and boards in the van parked at the <u>middle school field house</u>. All equipment must be dropped off at the middle school between 7:00 and 7:20 am. If equipment is dropped off at any other time during the school day, it may not be put on the van for the trip to Roundtop. Please refer to the map for drop-off location.



**CLOTHING:** Warm clothing including snow pants, winter coat, a hat, gloves or mittens are a must. Students can rent a locker at Roundtop, or keep their stuff in a cubby in the lodge. Helmets are also available for rent.

**LOCKER RENTALS**: Locker rentals are available at the student's expense. LDSD & Roundtop are not liable for damaged/stolen equipment, devices, or any other personal belongings.

**SPENDING MONEY**: Roundtop is **cashless**. You can link your credit card to your child's pass, or send them with a prepaid card. **Please do not send them with cash!** Packing a dinner is also an option.

<u>CLUB ADVISORS</u>: Mrs. Little is the high school advisor. Please direct all questions regarding Ski Club to jlittle@ldsd.org.

**NEVER SKI ALONE**: Everyone should always ski with friends. If you are skiing alone and something should happen to you, nobody would know you are in need of help.

**ACCIDENTS**: Roundtop has a Safety Patrol and a first aid station and have demonstrated good competency in the past. Any student who has an accident on the slopes should ask the Safety Patrol to page Mrs. Little. In the event of a serious injury, parents will be called to pick up their child and take them for medical follow-up.

<u>GUIDELINES FOR BEHAVIOR</u>: All students are required to abide by the Lower Dauphin Student Conduct Code and the smoking regulations and all of the rules set forth in this packet. When it is confirmed that a student was involved in an incident that causes embarrassment to the club and school or violates the student conduct code or the smoking regulations, that student will be dismissed from the club.

**BUS BEHAVIOR:** In addition to abiding by the Student Conduct Code and smoking regulations, all students should ensure that all trash is properly disposed of before exiting the bus. Be respectful to those around you, your driver, and the adults that are making this club available to you.

**ARRIVAL AT ROUNDTOP:** Students should go to the rental shop to pick up their equipment or may begin skiing/snowboarding once they have their equipment.

**RENTAL PROCEDURES**: Chaperones will assist students through the rental area and help them to get their equipment and proceed to the slopes.

<u>LESSONS</u>: In the interest of skier safety, **BEGINNERS must take at least 1 lesson**. Lessons are two hours long and must be scheduled no later than 24 hours before our Ski Club day. Please email Mrs. Little at <u>jlittle@ldsd.org</u> when you purchase your lesson.

<u>SKI SLOPE LIMITATIONS</u>: NO student should ski on slopes beyond their ability. If you had a lesson and your instructor did not take you on a slope of that difficulty, stay off.

**SKI CHECK:** Over the years, equipment has been stolen from our members. For your protection, store your equipment at Ski Check, located in front of the A-frame building at Roundtop.

**<u>DEPARTURE FROM ROUNDTOP</u>**: No student may board the bus to return to LDHS until a chaperone or advisor arrives at the bus.
